In order to receive a Linder Grant for the activity, project, equipment, seminar, or event you propose, please write a succinct, but complete, description of your proposal, addressing each of the areas outlined below. Please attach this cover page to your application and use no more than one page to answer each area. Please return your completed application to The Linder Foundation, c/o RandaLyn Novick, Central Kitsap Administration Building, by 4:30 p.m., Friday, March 20, 2009. **Please do not submit a hand-written proposal, although you may hand-print the requested information on this cover page.**

1. Provide a general description of your proposal.
2. Describe how the proposal relates to your school's academic curriculum or leadership goals and how it will benefit both you *and* your school. Discuss how you will disseminate to your fellow students and/or your teachers the information you acquire while taking part in your chosen activity, project, event, or seminar.
3. Provide a statement of merit: Tell about your capabilities, personal goals, accomplishments, recognition received. This statement may also include a statement of need explaining why it is important for you to receive assistance from the Linder Foundation.
4. Have a teacher, administrator, or staff member of the school you attend write an endorsement for your proposal. The endorsement should explain how this grant will help you meet the academic or leadership goals of the district or the school.
5. Provide a list of expenditures for which the grant will be used. For example, you may need funds for an application fee, tuition, room and board, materials, etc. Be as exact as possible.
6. Please indicate whether a partial grant would suffice.      \_\_\_ Yes \_\_\_ No

If your proposal is funded, sometime during the following school year, you may be asked to submit a written report explaining what you have learned while carrying out your Linder-funded project. You may also be asked to make a presentation at the Foundation's Annual Meeting.
