Questions and Answers

Q. What is the Reflections Program?

A. The Reflections Program is a National PTA and Washington State PTA arts recognition and achievement program for students.

The purpose of this program is to provide an opportunity for students to use their creative talents by expressing themselves through their own original works.

Q. Is the program theme-based?

A. Yes, it is theme-based and entries need to address this theme in the work.

Q. What is the theme for 2008-2009?

A. The theme is “ WOW! ”

Q. What is the deadline for submitting an entry?

A. Each school will have its own deadline, and this deadline will be anywhere between November 1-November 29.

Q. That deadline isn't too far into the school year, is it? Why?

A. Yes, you're right! This is because there are several other deadlines further along in the program that have to be met, and entries need to be judged and forwarded to the next level within certain time frames.

Q. Can you give me an example?

A. Certainly! The best example is a local one. All entries for the Central Kitsap School District must be submitted to the PTA Council no later than December 10th. So you can see---the schools really do need to set THEIR deadlines earlier!
